Tbs veg. oil
can chopped green chilies
tsp. ground cloves
tsp. sage
cans chicken broth
cloves of garlic
cup chopped onion
1/2 tsp. ground cumin
tsp. cayenne red pepper
cans great northern beans or white kidney beans
cups cooked cubed chicken



Saute onion, chilies and spices in a large Dutch oven. Stir in beans, broth, chicken and garlic. Bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer (uncovered) for 50-60 minutes. Garnish with chopped avocados.

Reporting back from the first annual South of the River CROP Hunger walk

October 13 was a glorious Minnesota fall day, and Spirit of Life responded with a wonderful turn out in support of the



CROP walk! The group was blessed during our morning worship service, fed a light lunch at Spirit of Life, and then made the drive over to St. James Lutheran Church in Burnsville to enjoy the pre-walk festivities and fellowship before embarking on a walk to raise awareness of hunger in our communities and our world, and to show solidarity with those who need to walk daily for food and water just to survive. As a congregation, Spirit of Life responded with donations of food—several grocery bags full—that were immediately

distributed to organizations that operate our community food shelves (360 Communities, Eagan/Lakeville Resource Center, and the CAP Agency). There was music at every stop along the way, with our Spirit of Life jazz ensemble (Rob and Cole Smith, Karen Johnson, Deon Ford, and Kate Olaf) providing music at the Sunset Pond rest stop. We had volunteers helping with registration (Peggy and Don Roeske, and Barb Ostlund), and our Scout Troop 292 provided volunteers to pick up route signs at the end of the walk. Our team of walkers was made up of Denise Lewis & Pat Skelly, Karen & Lyle Johnson, Sayra Maberry & Michael Tisland, Julie and Steve Raatz, Lisa & Luke Smith, Ethan Grimm, Linda Gulbrandson, Carol Osweiler, Rita Ryan, and Chris Sachs—and 4 dogs!

Thanks to everyone who participated in any way with this event! Although final numbers are not available, it was estimated that there were about 200 walkers, and the walk raised over \$11,500, with 25% designated to go to 360 Communities and the CAP Agency to support their hunger relief efforts locally. The Spirit of Life team raised over \$1,145. All in all, this was a very successful first effort, and the planning committee is already looking ahead to plan for next year. Thank you for your support in helping to end hunger one step at a time!
