Confirmation class meets the 1st & 3rd Sundays of the month following worship, 11:15am—12:30pm. If your youth has not been confirmed, is in 6th grade or older (we will have many senior high this time), and you plan on having them in confirmation this year, please see Pastor Rob. FROM COMMUNITY SERVICE: If you didn't get a chance to check out the Breaking Free Food Drive Tree in the sanctuary on Sunday, please drop by and help a bird to fly away (and bring back food). Spirit of Life is doing a food drive for the next 3 or 4 weeks for the food pantry at Breaking Free. This is a St. Paul based organization that helps women leave a life of prostitution. One of the many barriers that keep women trapped in that life is food insecurity, so Breaking Free offers a food pantry open to any woman who is participating in their programming. They are small, so they don't qualify for food donations from Second Harvest Heartland, and other such food distribution sources. They rely on churches to keep their pantry stocked, and currently they don't have a consistent church sponsor. Rosemount Family Resource Center seems to be well stocked these days, so stocking the Breaking Free Panty is an opportunity for us to make a real difference. Our goal is to fill 5 Cub food boxes; take a bird tag off the tree and bring back the item(s) listed on the tag. The program director will come to speak to us about the work they do, later in May (date TBD). Thank you for your generosity! For questions, talk to Denise Lewis.
