From Community Service: There are weekly opportunities to help in our food shelf donation garden. Weather permitting, we will typically plan to harvest produce after worship on Sundays, and maybe do a little weeding and maintenance, so if you are interested in participating, bring your gardening clothes and tools! A few people will also usually be working in the garden either Thursdays or Fridays in the morning on a weekly basis; contact Denise Lewis (dlewis9476@comcast.net) to confirm if the crew will be out there!

Everyone is welcome to join us for the weekly study on Wednesdays, 10 -11:30am, with Pastor Rob leading. Our next study begins July 11, covering the book of Mark. Anyone can join at any time. Class meets at the new Orchard Path Presbyterian Homes located just down the road at 5400 157th St. W., Apple Valley (South on Pilot Knob and turn left onto 157th St W. Orchard Path to the right after the traffic circle.)

Our **nursery** (located on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor) is open during worship for kids ages 1-6 years.

Today we receive the "Change for change" bucket offering. Throughout the month, we collect our change and then we bring it, on the second Sunday of the month, and give. Some are familiar with this, others may have questions. With the help of our children, we continue collecting change in our metal buckets on a monthly basis. This is a great teaching tool to help us show each other and the younger generation how fun it is to give when we hear the change drop in the buckets!

Our next midweek potluck & devotion night is Thursday, July 11. Plan to be here at 6pm with your potluck foods to share. We'll be grilling/eating and have a 10 minute devotion between 6:00 & 7:00 pm.
