Orchard Path is your senior living community neighbor, located less than a mile south, off of Pilot Knob Road and 157th Street. Save the date!"

Spirit of Life will again be participating in the **South of the River CROP Hunger Walk**, on Sunday October 7, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Lakeville. You are invited to join the team of walkers/ fundraisers (sign up, or talk to Denise Lewis), or you can participate by sponsoring a walker. You can do that by pledging a dollar amount per mile walked (4 mile route), or by pledging to match the walker's own fundraising efforts, up to a designated dollar amount. CROP Walks are organized to promote awareness and education about the issues of hunger locally and globally, as well as to raise money to create sustainable solutions to end hunger. Our Walk will provide 25% of the funds raised to 360 Communities, the CAP Agency, and the Open Door Pantry, and 75% to Church World Service. We learned at our recent hunger forum that 1 in 11 Minnesotans face hunger, including 1 in 8 Minnesota children. This affects health, productivity, and readiness to learn—things that we all pay for in the end when we don't prevent hunger in the first place. Let's do our part as a congregation, and raise \$2,000 for the 2018 South of the River CROP Walk!
