#### Our special services here at Spirit of Life Presbyterian Church during the Easter Season

Today, **Palm** Sunday, we celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem with the distribution of palms. An Easter Egg Hunt for children will follow the service.

Maundy Thursday, April 18, will feature the retelling of the story of Jesus' Last Supper with a potluck meal beginning at 6 p.m. Communion will be served as part of the meal. The Spirit of Life Youth Drama Club will act out the Crucifixion. The Drama Club is directed by Gladys Mbonifor.

Finally, on **Easter Sunday, April 21**, at the 10 a.m. worship service, along with two anthems by the Adult Choir, the Youth Drama Club will act out the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Communion also will be served.

During the Lenten Season the church has held **Wednesday evening devotional gatherings**, starting with a "kid-friendly" meal at 6 p.m. and devotions commencing about 6:20 p.m. A different church group has been hosting each of the suppers.

The final one will be on April 10.

Our **nursery** (2nd floor) is open during worship for children ages 1-6 years.

Today we will collect our "Change for Change" offering. Throughout the month, we collect our change and then we bring it, on the second Sunday of the month, to give in the bucket offering. With the help of our children, we continue collecting change in our metal buckets on a monthly basis. This is a great teaching tool to help us show each other and the younger generation how fun it is to give when we hear the change drop in the buckets!

Pastor Rob has set a scheduled time to be available for anyone who might wish to connect with him. Regular "office hours" are at the Dunn Bros., 15265
