Our special services here at Spirit of Life Presbyterian Church during the Easter Season

On Palm Sunday, April 14, 2019, at the 10 a.m. service the congregation will celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem with the distribution of palms. The Adult Choir and the Spirit of Life Youth Choir will perform. The Adult Choir is directed by Marge Lewis, with Martha Davis as pianist accompanist, and the Youth Choir is directed by Alvine Laure Ekame. An Easter Egg Hunt for children will follow the service.

Maundy Thursday, April 18, will feature the retelling of the story of Jesus' Last Supper with a potluck meal beginning at 6 p.m. Communion will be served as part of the meal. The Spirit of Life Youth Drama Club will act out the Crucifixion. The Drama Club is directed by Gladys Mbonifor.

Finally, on Easter Sunday, April 21, at the 10 a.m. worship service, along with two anthems by the Adult Choir, the Youth Drama Club will act out the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Communion also will be served.

During the Lenten Season the church has held Wednesday evening devotional gatherings, starting with a "kid-friendly" meal at 6 p.m. and devotions commencing about 6:20 p.m. A different church group has been hosting each of the suppers. The final one will be on April 10.
