Community Forum on our Changing Climate and Hunger, presented by the South of the River CROP Walk

Monday evening, September 16, 6:00-7:30 pm, Burnhaven Library Community Room, 1101 W County Road 42, Burnsville MN

Presenting Climate Realities and Solutions for Food and Water Sustainability Featuring speakers Veda Kanitz, Citizen's Climate Lobby; and, Rev. Dr. Paula Nordhem, co-coordinator of the South of the River CROP Hunger Walk.

We will explore the current realities of our changing climate and how the climate affects the global food supply. Then, we will present the ways Church World Service has, for over seventy years, worked in challenging environments after a human made or natural disaster, finding solutions and adaptations. With collaborative partners on the ground around the world, they put that learning into creating adaptive programs. The climate is changing rapidly especially in our most vulnerable ecosystems and there are solutions already in place and working for sustainability and to alleviate hunger.
