Our **nursery** (2nd floor) is open during worship for children ages 1-6 years.

Our stewardship campaign theme this year is "Won't You Be My Neighbor?" Each week in November, we will discuss being a neighbor. To conclude our Stewardship campaign, we'll share in worship at the Marcus Rosemount movie theater, 15280 Carrousel Way, Rosemount, MN 55068, on Sunday, November 24. We'll meet at the theater and begin at 10am as usual, then have a few preliminaries before watching the movie "Won't You Be My Neighbor?".

Throughout the month, we collect change and then bring it on the second Sunday (November 10) to give in the "Change for change" bucket offering.
