Gladys is the director of the Cameroon Women's Choir called "Christian Women Fellowship" who will be leading singing at the vigil. Amanda Craft, Manager of Advocacy, Office of Immigration Issues from our national office is flying in to show the support of our national church. And many leaders from our community are going to be here to share. One more important way you can help. Would you please write a personal letter helping express all the good that Gladys is and what she means for you, as well as expressing that her life is in danger if she is forced to return to Cameroon. For our little ones, if they would please color pictures showing their love of Gladys for us to include. Help share this request with people you know who would be willing to write a letter.


