
Something New



Turkey Burger Gyros

A recipe from Danielle Ullom

1/2 small onion chopped1 lb. 93% lean turkey1/4 tsp pepperSliced cucumberCherry tomatoesTZATZIKI SAUCEGreek salad dressing

2 cloves of garlic pressed 1/4 tsp salt Pita Pockets Lettuce or spinach leaves Feta cheese Plain Greek yogurt 1/4 cup cucumber chopped



Garlic clove pressed (can use carlic salt for a milder taste)

ALTERNATE: Use Wildtree Tzatziki Mix, follow package directions

Directions:

Brown turkey with onion, garlic, salt and pepper. Scoop into Pita Pockets. Top with veggies, feta cheese and sauce.


