

What Are We Waiting For?

"Indeed, these are not drunk..." One of my favorite lines as Peter is trying to explain what just happened. "They can't be, for it is only 9:00 in the morning." (Paraphrase from Acts 1) Ahhh...good old Pentecost. Be careful what you are waiting for, for you might find it. Or in the case of Pentecost—it might find you. Pentecost happens in the faithfulness of waiting. Jesus had instructed them to wait; to stay in Jerusalem and wait for the promise. Then Jesus left them; he ascended. The time of incarnation had ended. So wait they did. They went inside and waited. This small group was together in prayer, discernment, and worshiping.

Imagine, the closest followers who left everything behind to follow Jesus for three years. After everything they heard, observed, and even shared in, every one of them abandoned Jesus in the time of trial. If you want to talk about doubt, the disciples knew doubt. Not one of them came forward to share the promise that they remembered: He said this would happen, and, three days later he would be raised. Instead the disciples were somewhere along the line of 'now what?' Perhaps we should go back home to what we know? So what changed?

What happened for the disciples to go from dejected, secluded, locked in a room together and afraid, to what happens next? What happened is resurrection. They couldn't quite wrap their heads around this at first. The power of resurrection goes against all the laws of nature, but the power of God has no bounds. And whatever the disciples saw—now they were transformed. You don't just go from running away when most needed to leaving all security in a few short weeks unless the kind of change happens when you now fully believe with every ounce from within your soul.

And after waiting, the Holy Spirit breathed new life and the disciples went out. This time Jesus was not there . No one else came to take away their problems. What did they do? They went out. They risked everything because now they got it. Resurrection is real—Jesus is alive—it's time to go outside and do something. It is time to risk, to take chances, and even fail. Yes, I said it. Yes, even risk failure. Inside it feels safe; fortified within the walls. Think about this from the perspective of the disciples as by now, their numbers had dwindled, and the challenges were greater than ever.

And today, there are so many challenges. Life is busier than ever. We don't know our neighbors. Where is the money going to come from? Why



won't our children go to church? We have tried that before and it didn't work? We've never done it that way before? Busy, tired, broke, and finding it safe inside saying, "We don't know what to do?" Then when we know with conviction with every ounce of our soul, "He is Risen Indeed!", we realize that we are not too busy. We are rich, we are one, and the Lord is with us. May we see opportunity. May we see that following the wind, the noise, and the fire of Pentecost we cannot remain waiting. We find that we are the "we" we've been looking for. By following Pentecost, we are to go out and risk. We have a story tell. We can't help but go out and share it.

A quorum was present (8 of 9 Session members) for the Session meeting on April 10, which was rescheduled from March 20 and April 17. Pastor Smith offered an opening prayer and devotion based on John 13. The two most important long term plans for our church are: youth and children's programming and welcoming visitors.

The financial report was prepared by Barb Ostlund and discussed by the Session. Per capita is \$32.52. \$900 was spent on furnace and water heater repairs. Youth Group will be selling stock in May and June to help pay the final payment for the Mission Trip in July. We have a new fund set up for the former Farmington Presbyterian Church to cover the annual Dakota Co. Fair church service and deacons funds.

Pastor Rob gave his report. He discussed Confirmation class. Scott Milbradt, Cole Smith, and Nathan Plaszcz will be confirmed on April 27, 2014. Session voted to ask Tony Winter to be our Parish Associate.


