Spirit of Life Presbyterian Church Simplified Session Minutes December 9, 2014

A quorum was present as the Session meeting was called to order by the moderator, Reverend Rob Smith on December 9, 2014 for the combined November and December meetings.

Pastor Smith offered an opening prayer. He led a devotion based on Isaiah 40, the message of comfort to the Jews in exile in Babylon. We also watched a DVD called "Trees".

The financial report for October and November of 2014 was sent by Barb Ostlund. It was discussed that the budget is up by \$8890 (\$5109 of this from the Garage Sale) and expenses were down \$12,294 so net for the year we are up \$21,184. It was noted that the primary mortgage was down to \$13,767 and being paid off at \$1000 per month so it will be paid off in one year.

Pastor Rob gave his report concerning attendance, pastor visits, calendar of events, and outreach. It was noted to hold a special Session meeting on Dec. 14th at 11:15 to meet the new member class. It was also voted to spend \$550 from 2014 and \$550 from 2015 professional expense budget to purchase a new laptop for Pastor Smith. Bill Davnie will speak January 18 after worship service concerning the General Assembly's divestiture vote.

Minutes of the Stated Session meeting on October 23, 2014 were approved as read. Correspondence was read from First United Presbyterian church of Baldwin, WI that was a greeting and prayer for our church. Attendance was discussed.

Welcoming Guests committee had no report. Youth and Children's Programming committee had a report from Chris Sachs. It was approved to allow the youth to fundraise at the Valentine Cabaret for the Mission Trip. It was requested that Hub get a bid for an industrial size dishwasher for the kitchen and a bid to fix the Dove room bathroom. It was approved to refer to the Personnel committee to hire a child care attendant for Wed. nights from 6:30-8:30pm. Public Relations report was written by Peggy Roeske but there was no action needed. Worship and Music report was written by Karen Johnson. The Communion schedule for 2015 was approved. Stewardship report was given by Bob Shepard. 33 units pledged donations to the church. Pledges were up \$15,000 over 2014. Bob Shepard and his committee were thanked. HUB committee report was written by Walt Ullrich. There was no action needed. Personnel committee had no action items. Adult Ed. report was submitted by Brian Gracek. No action was needed. Nomination committee will be formed. It will consist of 2 Elders, 1 Deacon and 2 members at large. Audit committee had no report.

Deacon meeting minutes for November were submitted by Loretta Hunt.

Old Business: Visioning discussion was postponed until January. Each committee submitted a list of activities for the year so that we can do a calendar of activities. Karen Johnson will combine all of these into one calendar and e-mail it to the Session members. The draft version of the pictorial directory was viewed. We are still waiting for more pictures to be submitted.

New Business: The Annual Congregational meeting will be February 1, 2014. All committees should submit their reports to Shari by January 15, 2015. Clerk Karen Johnson will review the rolls and reports for Presbytery at the January meeting.

Concerns and joys of individuals were expressed and prayers were offered. The meeting was closed with a prayer.
