Notice: To begin our congregational study of immigration issues, on November 3, following worship in the adult Christian Ed time, we will have a circle to share family immigration stories—the stories of children and grandchildren of immigrants. This would be an opportunity to share how your family history played a role in developing your personal values, and how that story affects how you view immigration today. It is our hope that this will offer us a broad historical context for immigration in the US, hopefully capturing stories coming out of many waves of immigration over the years, Scandinavian, European, Hispanic, Asian, and African. Everyone is invited to attend this event whether or not you have a story to share, but if you want to share your family immigration story, please notify Joanne Boyd, Denise Lewis, or Bob Shepard, so we have an idea how many stories

we will be starting with. As we move through our immigration study, we will shift our focus to current issues, but we felt it would be helpful to start with some historical context first.
