Coffee and Conversations will return tomorrow, July 11. Join us at the Panera, Apple Valley (in person only – no zoom). Coffee and Conversations meets Mondays, from 9:00 am to 10:00 am. During Pastor Rob's sabbatical this summer, Bob Shepard is leading the weekly coffee and conversation time with the above hours. Come as you are. It is open for you to pop in and out any time so feel free to drop in and say hello.

The session of elders of Spirit of Life is hosting our regular community **PICNICS** this year while Rob has sabbatical. We ask those able to bring a side or dessert to share and the session will provide a main course. Remaining dates are **July 31**st, **and August 28**th and the time will be approximately 11:15am (immediately after worship) with games in the backyard for kids and food and fellowship for all.

Spirit of Life was offered the opportunity to purchase a classroom set of **used guitars**, at a steep discount. With Session approval, these guitars were purchased and are now in our possession. There are plans in the works to incorporate options for group guitar lessons into Meet in the Middle programming, and 12 guitars will be available for participating students to borrow. But, that still leaves an extra 12 guitars that are available for purchase for personal use; 4 church members have already requested the opportunity to purchase a guitar, so there are still 8 guitars available for sale. The cost is \$70 per guitar. They are beginner Yamaha CGS104A full sized, nylon string classical guitars. (Classical are smaller than full sized steel string-good for smaller hands). New, the cost of the equivalent of this guitar is approximately \$150. Used, between \$90-\$100; so this is a good deal. The guitars come with a case; there is wear and tear on the cases, and all of the guitars should have the strings replaced, so you would be purchasing them "as is". To repeat: children who may want to participate in Meet in the Middle group guitar lessons WILL NOT need to purchase a guitar; they will be available to borrow. If you are interested in purchasing a guitar, please contact Denise Lewis, <u>dlewis9476@comcast.net</u> to get the details.
