From Community Service: **March is MN FoodShare month**, which we participate in each year; all of our food and dollar donations go directly to the Rosemount Family Resource Center. You can bring in non-perishable food items (shelf-stable proteins, baking items, canned fruits and vegetables, or personal care items) and place them in empty grocery bags strategically placed throughout the sanctuary representing the 1 in 6 of our neighbors experiencing food insecurity. You can pick up a detailed list of the most needed food shelf items at the back of the sanctuary. Food shelfs also strongly encourage dollar donations, because they can stretch those donations to provide more resources. This year, our committee is asking for donations in increments of \$25, \$50, or \$100, so we can fully deck out our "ambassador" snowman! It will take \$700 to get him fully decorated — watch the progress week by week. Make checks out to "Spirit of Life" with MN FoodShare on the memo line, or donate online making that same note.

GriefShare Program runs through May 4, 2023 (no meeting Maundy Thursday), 6:30 pm at Spirit of Life Church, Apple Valley. This program features biblical, Christ -centered teaching that focuses on grief topics associated with the death of a loved one. The seminar features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories of people, followed by a small group discussion about what was viewed. Many grieving people find they are only beginning the work of healing when friends or family have returned to their daily life routines. Too often people, including Christians, tend to bury their grief instead of allowing it to do the God-given work for which it is intended. Don't allow fear of what others may think to keep you from what could help you. Confidentiality is very much a part of this program. The community service team designates the first Sunday of every month as **little free pantry Sunday**. As we remember the sacred Last Supper, let us also think of our neighbors in need of food support. For February, we are in need of items that can withstand freezing temperatures. This means NO CANS OR GLASS CONTAINERS. Some items that are useful include white rice, cereal, jelly (plastic bottles only) peanut butter (plastic jars only) pasta, spaghetti sauce (plastic jars only), Mac and cheese boxes, tuna in foil packets, etc. Our pantry has proven very helpful - we notice items being taken very shortly after placement on the shelves. We've also received a note of thanks from one user. Thanks so much for supporting this mission.
