The **South of the River CROP Walk** was a success again this year, with a total of 54 walkers; the food drive provided 1,549 pounds of non-perishable items for the CAP Agency of Scott County; total funds raised for our Walk -- \$15,096.88. Spirit of Life had a total of 13 walkers, and some additional volunteers; our total of the fundraising was \$2,444.80. MANY, MANY, thanks to all who participated in this year's Walk — from buying

pies or other baked goods, providing baked goods for sale, donating items to the food drive, walking, fundraising, participating in the Papa Murphy's fundraiser, and the many prayers offered in support! In all of those ways, you helped to make the CROP Walk a success again this year, and 25% of what we raised will support the mission of Second Harvest Heartland to end hunger locally.

From our own backyard, our food shelf donation garden was severely impacted by the drought this year; we were able to donate only 571 pounds, which was below our average of 700-800 pounds, and way below our donation of over 1100 pounds last year. Hopefully, we will have better rain next year.
