An offering from Interfaith Creation Care of the South Metro: **Earth Day 2025** is arriving soon! The Church of the Risen Savior and their Environmental Concerns Committee have arranged for a special speaker, Dr. Joe Fargione, Director of Science for the Nature Conservancy's North America Region. The talk is titled Climate Change 101 and is free to all who attend. Dr. Fargione's work has focused on quantifying nature's benefits to people, including the potential for nature to contribute to fighting climate change. He was an author of the Fifth National Climate Assessment and has testified before Congress on Natural Climate Solutions. The event is scheduled for Earth Day April 22nd at 7 pm. Notice from Justice Works Committee: Sacred Sites Tours scheduled for 2025 These tours are part of Minnesota Council of Churches Healing Minnesota Stories initiative. Sacred Sites: We visit sites located around confluence of the Mississippi and Minnesota rivers, what the Dakota refer to as Bdote, or "meeting place of rivers," including: Fort Snelling State Park; Dakota Internment Camp following the The Dakota-U.S. War; Pilot Knob Hill, a traditional burial ground.
